

Dooring Policy *(last updated 26/2/14)*

The clubroom is designed to facilitate socialisation between club members and clubroom-based events, any action by members which disrupts this design will not be tolerated. Continuation of such behaviour will result in banning from the clubroom.

Committee and CCC reserve the right to request that people leave the room (dooring) for a number of reasons:

- racist, misogynistic, sexist, homophobic or otherwise discriminatory behaviours or speech
- infringement of the clubroom rules
- persistent, intentional mention of triggering subjects resulting in discomfort of members present in the clubroom
- physical abuse or inappropriate contact (sexual harassment) of members
- damaging club assets
- other behaviour disruptive to the social setting, including obnoxious behaviour (yelling, singing)

The length of dooring is determined by the enforcing Committee or CCC member depending on the severity of the action, but cannot exceed beyond the next committee meeting. Any dooring extended until the committee meeting will be reviewed by the committee and can be extended or ended as the committee decides. Banning cannot exceed six months without review by a General Meeting.

Any dooring of a Committee or CCC member will be met with review of their position in the next committee meeting. CCC may only be doored by a Committee or more than one CCC member. Committee members (other than President) may only be doored by the President or more than one Committee member. The President can only be doored by the President (Guild reasons; if you have issue with the President, call an SGM).

These rules are subject to review and alteration by Committee, and this doc will be edited to reflect that.
