

Facebook Rules *(last updated 26/2/14)*

Racist, homophobic, misogynist or inflammatory remarks will not be tolerated in the clubroom OR the Facebook group. If members continue posting them, they will be removed from the group.

The Facebook group admins (committee) reserve the right to moderate and remove any content posted to the Facebook group that could be reasonably considered as

- being racist, misogynistic, sexist, homophobic or otherwise discriminatory
- off topic
- an exhausted topic

This includes posts, links and comments made by anyone on the Facebook group or page.

Any post requiring removal will be screenshotted prior to removal, the reason for removal of the post/comment will be explained and the posting member will be warned that further infractions may result in banning. If warnings continue to be disregarded the offending member will be banned from the Facebook group (but not from the clubroom) until the next committee meeting, where the ban will be reviewed and can be extended up until the next AGM where the succeeding committee will review the ban.

Where possible, committee will strive to preserve any appropriate posts or comments on the Facebook. Committee acknowledges, however, that extreme situations may demand removal of appropriate material.

If a member finds a comment they believe comes under these categories, they are recommended to let the committee know rather than argue about the issue online as this can just exacerbate the problem. We encourage members with concerns to approach the club rather than remaining quiet and distancing themselves from the club.

These rules are subject to review and alteration by Committee, and this doc will be edited to reflect that.
